Nole's Win Over Wildcats

Florida St. scored on their first two possessions and the 'Nole defense shutdown the Wildcat offense as FSU came out on top 22-6.

Starting on their own 20 yard line, the Seminoles drove the length of the field, capped by a Austin Moreno 16 yard run. Tommy Chavez kicked the PAT to make the score 8-0.

The stubborn Seminole defense stopped Kentucky cold. FSU took over the ball on downs and again drove down the field, scoring on a Darien Rivera 4 yard run. Chavez again added the PAT kick to make the score 16-0 at half.

In the second half, it was more of the same, as the defense again held the Cat offense. Florida St. scored quickly, this time on an exciting 40 yard run by Chavez.

Great blocking up front allowed the Seminoles to gain over 100 yards on the ground. Hayden Wideman and Kenny Peterson each tallied 8 blocks, while Andres Quesada and Johnny Benitez each ad 6. Ian Beltran, Kasen Gallagher, Nathan Medina and Adrian Alcocer each had 4 blocks.

Great team defense was the key once again as seven players had three tackles; Austin Moreno, Daniel Silvestre, Darien Rivera, Mike Zambrano, Justin Acosta, Ryan McLean, and Mark Rubalcava. Kyle Horton, Tommy Chavez, Donovan Manabanda and Kenny Peterson had two tackles each. Safeties McLean and Manabanda played exceptionally well, each knocking down passes. McLean also recovered a loose fumble early in the game and returned it 16 yards.

The win improves the Seminole's record to 6-0 and sets up the biggest game of the season against the Tarheels this Saturday. The Seminoles squeaked by the Tarheels early in the season 13-12.
