'Noles Snag Falcons

The FSU Seminoles earned a hard-fought road victory defeating the Upland Falcons 26-12 last Saturday to improve their record to 6-0.

The ground game was in full gear for the 'Noles, as they picked up 191 yards in just 18 plays, an average of 10.6 yards per play. Matthew Chavez had two long runs of 42 and 25 yards, both for touchdowns. Steven Comstock had a 38 yard run for a TD, and Noah Rodriguez had a 25 yard scoring run. Raymond Serrano picked up 46 yards on the ground as well. Matthew Avila picked up a PAT on a 3 yard run, and gained 12 yards on the day.

The defense was led by corner Mason DeLos Santos who had 7 tackles. Johnny Padilla, Aaron McCraven, Matthew Chavez and Steven Comstock had 5 tackles each. Joseph Romero, Robert Garcia and Noah Rodriguez had 3 tackles each.

The Seminoles face second place Miami this Saturday at Russell Park.
