FSU Teams Remain Undefeated

Both the A and A-1 teams improved their record to 5-0 with wins over North Carolina and Upland last week.

In weekday action, the A-1's defeated NCU 14-8. Josh Lagal and Richard Lopez led the squad with 6 points each. Joey Davis, Patrick Bartolotti and Thomas Coupland led in the rebounding department with 6 each.

The A's were in a close contest until late in the game as they defeated the Tarheels 35-17. Noah Rodriguez led the Seminoles with 10 points, while Aaron McCraven scored 8. Matt Avila scored 8 points as well, including two 3-point shots. Joseph Romero chipped in 4 points, and Raymond Serrano and Matt Chavez each scored 2. Steven Comstock had 1 point, but led the team in rebounds with 10.

On Saturday, the teams traveled to Upland to take on the Falcons. The A-1's defeated the Falcons 32-15, led by Mason De Los Santos who scored 17 points. Mason also dished out 6 assists and had 8 stolen balls. Richard Lopez continued his steady shooting with 7 points, while Josh Lagal and Joey Davis each added 4 points. Davis also led the team in rebounds with 10.

The A's took the court next and dominated the Falcons by winning 51-2. Stifling defense by the Seminoles accounted for 17 stolen balls, led by Matt Chavez and Noah Rodriguez who had 5 steals each. Scoring was balanced as every player scored. Aaron McCraven led the way with 10 points, followed by Matt Chavez with 9. Steven Comstock, Raymond Serrano and Noah Rodriguez each scored 8, and Joseph Romero added 4.
