'Noles Edge Hurricanes

The Seminole AA's laid claim to first place and remained undefeated after winning a tough battle against the Miami Hurricanes 22-16.

The Hurricanes struck first, scoring early in the 1st half after an FSU fumble deep in Hurricane territory to make the score 0-8. (This was the first TD the starting FSU defense had allowed in two seasons).

On the ensuing kickoff, Raymond Serrano returned the kick 41 yards for a touchdown, and Steven Comstock added the PAT to lock the score at 8-8.

Miami scored again, this time on a long Mikey Sjodt run and the 'Caines regained the lead 16-8.

The Seminoles came roaring back, led by rookie quarterback Noah Rodriguez who drove the Seminoles down the field. Rodriguez finished the drive with a 1 yard burst. The PAT was short and the Seminoles went into halftime trailing 14-16.

In the second half, the Seminole defense toughened up as the held Miami to just 22 yards in offense, and more importantly, kept them out of the end zone. Comstock led the defense with 9 tackles. Raymond Serrano and Aaron McCraven had 5 solo takedowns, while Noah Rodriguez, Elijah Palacio and Joseph Romero had 4. Ricky Lopez and Josh Lagal played flawless pass defense not allowing a completion. They both finished with 2 tackles along with Mason De Los Santos.

The Seminoles offense struggled in the second half, coughing up the pigskin on their first drive on the Hurricane 4 yard line. On their second drive, Comstock rambled 31 yards on an X play for the go ahead score. Matt Avila had a key block on that play to spring Comstock, which gave the 'Noles a 22-16 lead. The offensive line had their work cut out for them, and they were up to the challenge. Aaron McCraven and Alex Alvarez led the line play with 9 blocks each, followed by Romero and Rodriguez with 5. Patrick Bartolotti and Joey Davis each had 4 blocks each. Comstock gained 51 yards on 6 carries, while Rodriguez gained 17 yards on 5 carries.

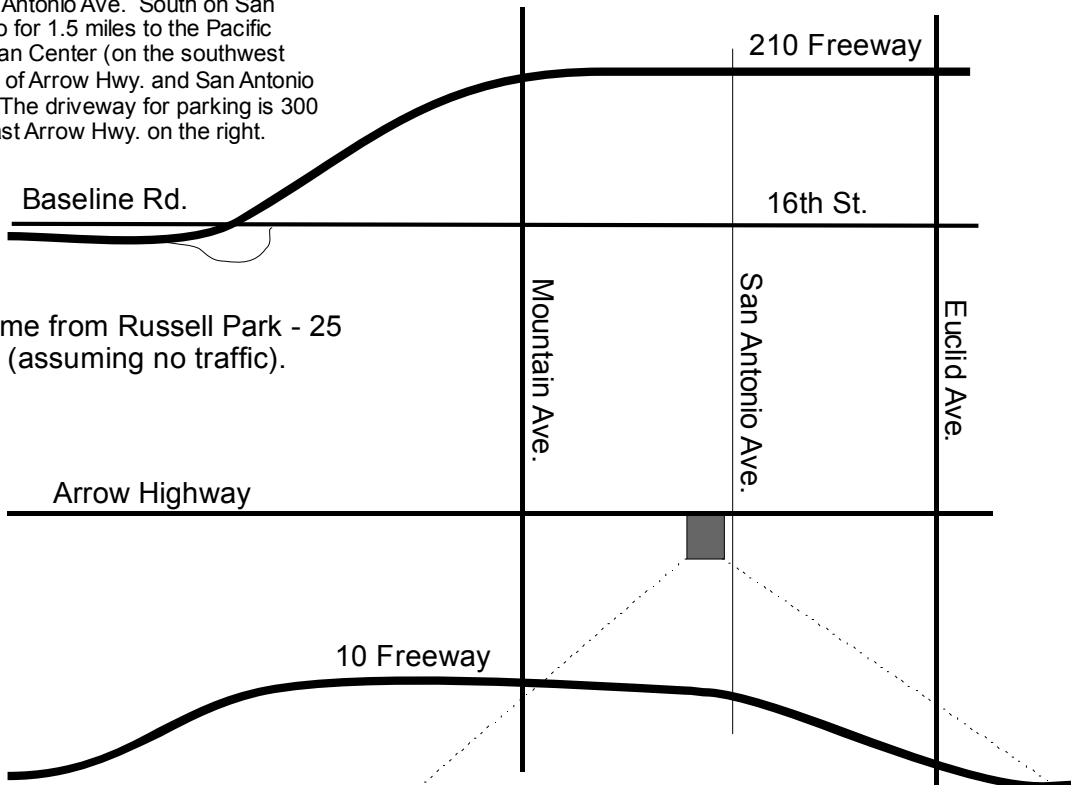

Directions for Upland Falcons Game

Pacific Christian Center
800 W. Arrow Highway
Upland, CA 91786

210 - Exit Baseline Rd. Proceed east 1.9 miles (Baseline turns into 16th St.) to San Antonio Ave. South on San Antonio for 1.5 miles to the Pacific Christian Center (on the southwest corner of Arrow Hwy. and San Antonio Ave.). The driveway for parking is 300 feet past Arrow Hwy. on the right.



Travel time from Russell Park - 25 minutes (assuming no traffic).

10 Freeway - Exit Mountain Ave. North 0.8 miles to Arrow Hwy. East on Arrow Hwy. for 0.5 miles to San Antonio Ave. Pacific Christian Center is on the Southwest corner of Arrow Hwy. and San Antonio Ave. Turn south on San Antonio Ave. 300 feet to driveway. Turn right into driveway for parking.
