This is an introductory course exploring concepts in physical science. Concepts such as matter, mixtures, atoms, the periodic table, chemical reactions, motion, forces, buoyancy, and electricity will be discussed.

Absences: Participation in class is so important in learning another language that you cannot expect to do well if you are frequently absent. If you are absent, it is *your responsibility* to see that your homework is completed the day you return. If you have missed a test or quiz due to an excused absence, it is *your responsibility* to make the quiz or test up within one week following your return.
